How does the game work?

There are 2 draws to pick the Lucky Lotteries winners.

The first draw chooses the winning numbers. To take home one of the 10 levels of cash prizes, your number needs to match one of the winning numbers drawn. If you happen to be 1 number off a winning number, you'll even win a consolation prize.

The second draw determines if someone wins the jackpot. If the number drawn in this second draw matches any of the winning numbers (excluding Consolation Prizes) from the first draw, the Jackpot Prize is won!

System entry

This entry allows you to play more numbers, with more chances to win across multiple prize divisions. We've got a How to Play Systems guide you can find in-store.



QuickPick

Just like the name suggests, it's a quick and easy way to play. Your numbers will be randomly generated for you.



Marked entry

Do you like to choose your own numbers? Create your own entry. Grab a coupon in-store or select 'create your own' online or via The Lott app.



Top up

You can mark a few panels on a coupon, then top up your entry to any QuickPick level.



Play again

If you're keen on keeping the same numbers, just present your existing entry in-store and ask to 'play it again'. You can do this for all entries except Lucky Lotteries and syndicates.



Boxed entry

A Boxed entry can be played with Lotto Strike and means your numbers can be drawn in any order within the first 4 balls drawn. Head to thelott.com for more information.



Advance entries / draws

If you like, you can play your entry in a future draw up to 9 weeks in advance for Lotto, Oz Lotto, Powerball, Set for Life and Lotto Strike.



Multi-week entries
